

SUMMER 2020 – CAMP POLICY

Maximum number of students (updated)

As of August 4 and following the recent changes in legislation, we will keep a maximum of 13 students plus 2 staff members in our camp.

Classroom renovation & material/supplies

- We have enlarged and redesigned the main classroom to increase activity space for students. Movement inside the classroom will be supervised by teachers.
- Sharing of materials and supplies will be limited or avoided.

Drop-off and pick-up procedures

- Morning drop-off window is 8:45-9:00 A.M. and pick-up is 3:45-4:00 P.M. (does not apply to Extended Care option).
- Drop off and pick-up take place at the front door – No parents will be allowed inside.
- Parents will stay 6 feet apart in case of outdoor line up.

Health check/screening

Parents will ensure each child is reasonably fit to participate in the camp and is not experiencing any symptoms of Covid-19 including fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat or painful swallowing, runny nose, nasal congestion, loss of taste or smell, headache, fatigue.

- Ma Classe will keep a record of each student's daily temperature taken at drop off.
- If a teacher observes signs of illness in a child, parents will be contacted immediately to pick-up. S/he will wait in a supervised area until s/he can go home.
- If a child or family member in the household is sick, please stay home and call to let us know. If a teacher is sick, s/he will stay home.

Hand washing and cleaning

- Frequent daily hand washing using soap and water indoors and hand sanitizer outdoors. One student at a time, at the sink area.
- Students will be responsible for cleaning their own tools.
- Frequently touched surfaces (including washroom) will be cleaned and sanitized regularly throughout the day.
- All equipment & toys will be sanitized before and after use. Plush toys are not available.

- Students will be kept at a safe distance from any outsider during outdoor activities in High park.
No city outdoor play structures will be used.

Food & Allergies

Peanut or nut products are strictly prohibited on our premises or during outdoor activities.

- Children bring labelled non-breakable water bottle and food container with their own snack & lunch.
No food sharing.

What to wear/bring

Children should be dressed in comfortable clothes and shoes for indoor and outdoor activities.

- A cloth mask/face covering.
- Indoor shoes, personal sunscreen and a hat.
- An old T-shirt to be worn during painting, arts and crafts activities.
- No toys or games in backpack.

Refund /Transfer

Ma Classe will make a full refund if the camp is cancelled due to staff illness. Transfers may be permitted if there are spaces available in other camp weeks.
